## STATUTORY DECLARATION UNDER RTI ACT

Our college is a 'College of Co-education' and its mother institution 'Balasaheb Mane Education Trust, Rukadi' is registered under Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 Act by the Govt. of Maharashtra. The college is affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur, (M.S.) The College has a Board of Trustees approved by the authority appointed by the Govt. of Maharashtra. It runs as per rules and regulations made by the Govt. of Maharashtra from time to time.

The College comes under the 'Grant in Aid' category. Therefore, its financial transactions are audited by the government.
