Code of Ethics in Research

- 1. Research must be authentic and original
- 2. Research should be pursued as per the standard of discipline
- 3. The accuracy of research data should be insured
- 4. Misleading statements or declarations vague assumptions should be avoided as they are symbol of misinterpretation.
- 5. Sources of information and data should be clearly cited.
- 6. Proper acknowledgement and credit should be offered to resources / funding sources of the research
- 7. Details and complete records of the undertaken research should be kept intact
- 8. Transparency in the use and disbursement of resource should be maintained
- 9. It should be ensured that the results of the research are accessible to the public after the completion of research.
- 10. Experts' opinion regarding research should be taken.
- 11. Plagiarism standards will be as per the university norms.
